

Cookies Policy

In compliance with the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), we hereby inform you that our web page uses cookies to personalize content and ads, provide social media features and analyze site traffic.

For all other types of cookies, we need your permission. This means that cookies categorized as necessary are processed based on GDPR Art. 6 (1) (f). All other cookies, meaning those in the preferences and marketing categories, are processed based on GDPR Art. 6 (1)(a).

This section provides information about our cookie collection and management policy.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard Internet log and visitor behavior information. When you visit our website we may collect information from you automatically through cookies or similar technologies. Cookies allow a web page to, among other things, store and retrieve information about a user's browsing habits or equipment. Depending on the information they contain and the way in which you use your equipment, cookies can be used to recognize a user.

WHAT TYPES OF COOKIES DO WE USE?

This website uses the following types of cookies:

- First-party cookies: those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a device or domain managed by the publisher itself and from which the service requested by the user is provided.
- Third-party cookies: those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a device or domain that is not managed by the publisher but by another entity that processes the data obtained through cookies.
- Session cookies: those that are designed to collect and store data while the user accesses a web page. They are typically used to store information that is only required to provide the service requested by the user at one time (e.g., a list of purchased products).
- Persistent cookies: those that remain stored in the terminal and can be accessed and processed during a period of time defined by the person responsible for the cookies, which can range from a few minutes to several years.





- Embedded social media cookies: those that allow visitors to interact with the content of different social platforms (Facebook, YouTube, X, LinkedIn, etc.) and are generated only for the users of said social networks. The conditions of use of these cookies and the information collected are regulated by the privacy policies of the corresponding social media platforms.
- Analysis cookies: those that are processed by us or by third parties in a way that allows us to quantify our visitors as well as measure and analyze our users' interactions with the services we offer. With these cookies, your browsing on our website is analyzed to improve the range of services that we offer you.

DISABLE COOKIES

You can allow, block or delete the cookies installed on your device by configuring the options of the browser you use on your device.

Most web browsers offer the option of allowing, blocking or deleting the cookies installed on your device.
